

## Minnesota: Education to Workforce Data

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## **MN SLEDS Overview**

- The Minnesota Statewide Longitudinal Education Data System (SLEDS) matches student data from K12 through completion of postsecondary and into the workforce.
- Uses a matching algorithm based on PII to link records across 7 state agencies.
- Jointly managed by the Minnesota Office of Higher Education (OHE), Minnesota Department of Education (MDE), and Minnesota Department of Employment and Economic Development (DEED).
- Governed by the Minnesota P-20 Education Partnership.
- Core data sets: K12 enrollment, postsecondary enrollment and completion (OHE + National Student Clearinghouse), employment (unemployment insurance database)
  - Postsecondary completions from all public and private colleges in Minnesota from FY2007-on.
  - Employment data on all UI-covered Minnesota employment from FY2003-on. Includes wages, hours worked, and industry but not occupation.

## Accessing SLEDS Data



- Public site available to everyone <u>https://sleds.mn.gov/#</u>. Data is organized by cohorts: high school and college.
- Schools and Colleges can request access to data on their students, including deidentified individual-level data through a secure portal.
- Access to individual level data for a specific research project available through an application process.

- Colleges and universities using MN SLEDS data for in-depth analysis of employment outcomes of their graduates.
- School districts using MN SLEDS data to analyze the employment impact of college and career academies.
