

The PSEO Explorer can help university staff members answer:

- How much have graduates earned after graduation?
- Where have graduates been employed?
- In which industries have graduates been employed?
- What are the economic outcomes for industries known as high social value, such as health care and education?



Our data offer insights such as:

- The annual earnings by degree for graduates after one year, five years, and 10 years.
- Which industries graduates have been employed in recently, by degree program.
- Whether graduates have been employed in-state or elsewhere.
