DOWNLOADING THE DATA – EXCEL

1. In your browser, go to the [PSEO Explorer](#) home page.
2. On the left, select the state whose data you want to download.
3. In the upper right, click Download Data.

DOWNLOADING THE DATA – CSV

1. In your browser, go to the [PSEO Explorer](#) home page.
2. In the upper right, click Help.
3. Under Download Public-Use Data, select an option for State/Territory.
4. Click View Files.
5. Click the file you would like to download.

The PSEO Earnings (pseoe) and PSEO Flows (pseof) files are each compressed in a .gz format. You will need to unzip these files prior to using the CSV files inside them.
